Non-Academic Fees

4-H Clover Club Dues - \$3.00 - Students interested in participating in the 4-H club will pay this fee at designated time established by the sponsor. For 2nd graders only.

Girl Scouts – girls interested in participating in Girl Scouts must pay a \$25.00 fee. Students in grades K-2nd are eligible to participate.

Second fighting infraction - \$50.00 - Students who violate the Code of Conduct fighting policy a second time will pay this fee.

Technology Repair Fee - \$50.00 – this fee is for students who damage any laptops or any other technology at the school site.

Registration Fee - \$5.00 - The school administration collects this fee during Pre-registration for student ID cards.

PE Uniform - \$25.00 - Students who take PE classes must pay this fee for the purchase of their PE uniform.

Technology Repair Fee - \$50.00 – this fee is for students who damage any laptops or any other technology at the school site.

4-H Club Dues - \$3.00 - Students interested in participating in the 4-H club will pay this fee at designated time established by the sponsor.

FFA Club Dues - \$15.00 - Students interested in participating in FFA will pay this fee at the designated time established by the sponsor.

Athletic Football Fee - \$50.00 - Student athletes pay this fee for uniforms and equipment. It is due prior to participation in the sport.

Senior Dues - \$100.00* - All seniors pay this fee for senior trips, prom decorations, graduation decorations, bacallourette activity, and all other senior class events.

Junior Dues - \$120.00* - All juniors pay this fee for prom decorations and all other junior class events.

Cell Phone Fee – students will be required to pay a \$25.00 fee for cell phones found in their possession during the school day.

Second fighting infraction - \$50.00 - Students who violate the Code of Conduct fighting policy a second time will pay this fee.

Collection of Unpaid Fees
