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What We Are Learning

English & Language Arts (ELA) Reading:

What are we learning as we read?

How to retell stories; include key details, and demonstrate an understanding of the central message or lesson; and sequential ordering of events.

Math: Reviewing addition and subtraction number bonds for *Hawk Hour*, and skip counting by tens.

Science & Social Studies: Spiders.

Homework

Below are homework assignment and/or skills to review at home with your child.

ELA: Retell in sequential order key details; Understand the concept of having an opinion and write simple sentences using spelling words. Review vocabulary words.

Math: Tuesday – Practice at home skip counting by tens.

Spelling Words: has, look, two, more, red, bed, fed, sled-**High frequency words:** *has, look, two.* **Monday**- write each word eight times each. **Tuesday** – read each word out loud and write two sentences using each word. **Wednesday** – put each word in alphabetical order. **Thursday** – perform a mock spelling test.

Vocabulary Words: approached, quarreling, satisfied, acknowledge, sneakily, slithered, strategize, dangled, original, intricately, fastened, proclaimed.
