2018-2019 School Uniform Policy

The purpose for implementing a student dress code policy for all students is to strengthen the learning environment for classroom instruction and academic performance, increase school pride, and enhance the image of our students and the school in our community. All students will dress for success.

St. Helena Early Learning Center (PreK-2)

- Light blue or basic red polo shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy blue or khaki pants or knee-length shorts
 - No Capri pants allowed
 - All pants are to be worn at the waist.
- Black or navy-blue belt
- Tennis shoes

St. Helena Arts and Technology Academy (3-6)

- Light blue or basic red polo shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy blue or khaki pants or knee-length shorts
 - No Capri pants allowed
 - All pants must be worn at the waist.
- Black or navy-blue belt
- Tennis shoes

Outerwear for Both Schools

- Navy blue or black vest
- Black button-down cardigan
- All black, navy blue, or gray jacket/coat
- Tennis shoes

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED

- Denim or denim-like fabrics
- Brand name logos on clothing or outerwear
- Colorful undergarments under school shirt
- Solid school bags
- Sagging
- Ballerina or slip on shoes
- Hooded jackets or sweatshirts
- ***Light-colored or very dark khaki pants are not acceptable. (Use khaki Dickies as the example when selecting pants).***

St. Helena College and Career Academy (7-12)

- **7th & 8th grade students:**
Solid light blue polo shirts
Navy blue pants (No capris)
- **9th grade students:**
Solid white polo shirts
Khaki pants (No capris)
- **10th – 12th grade students:**
Solid Gold or Black polo shirts
Khaki pants (No capris)

OTHER GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Standard uniform khaki pants
(NO tight fitting/stretch pants type pants such as jeans, biking shorts, sweat pants, wind suits, flair pants, or overalls; no skorts, skirts or jumpers. No joggers)
CARGO PANTS, PANTS WITH EXTRA POCKETS, LARGE POCKETS ARE PROHIBITED.
Students are not allowed to tuck pant legs into socks or shoes.
2. Light-colored or very dark khaki pants are not acceptable. (Use khaki Dickies as the example when selecting pants).
3. Undershirts will have sleeves no longer than sleeves of the uniform shirt. A Physical Education shirt may be used as an undershirt. All shirts, uniform and undershirts must always be neatly tucked in the front and back.
4. Your regulation uniform belt must always be visible.
5. Sweatshirts/Jackets – **No Hooded sweatshirts & jackets will be allowed.** SHCCA's Official Sweat Shirt or approved Athletic SHCCA Sweat Shirts will be worn. The only alternative will be non-hooded PLAIN white, or black sweatshirts. Sweatshirts will not be worn inside out. Thermal shirts will not be worn around school as a sweatshirt.

**WE WILL STRICTLY

Students must have a
Clear or mesh school bag

No sagging or over-sized
pants

No open-toed, backless or
ballerina-style footwear is
allowed.

6. Lightweight parkas, jackets or sweaters with no visible logo and without a hood may be worn over the navy tops inside the building. Uniform shirt collars must be worn out with sweatshirts, sweaters, etc.
7. ONLY plain brown, black, blue, navy blue, white or khaki belts are acceptable. NO DESIGNS/DECORATIONS – no rivets, no holes, no jewels/stones, no embroidery. Belts must be worn on bottoms with belt loops. Belt buckles are to be no more than 2 inches by 2 inches. Shirts and blouses must be tucked in.
8. Any tennis shoe is acceptable.
