## St. Helena Parish School District 2016-2017 Uniform Policy

The purpose for implementing a student dress code policy for all students is to strengthen the learning environment for classroom instruction and academic performance, increase school pride, and enhance the image of our students and the school in our community. All students will dress for success.

### St. Helena Early Learning Center (PreK-2)

- Light blue or basic red polo shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy blue pants or knee-length shorts
  - No Capri pants allowed
  - All pants must be worn at the waist. No sagging or over-sized pants will be allowed.
- Black or navy blue belt
- All black shoes or all black tennis

### St. Helena Arts and Technology Academy (PreK-6)

- Light blue or basic red polo shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy blue pants or knee-length shorts
  - No Capri pants allowed
  - All pants must be worn at the waist. No sagging or over-sized pants will be allowed.
- Black or navy blue belt
- All black shoes or all black tennis

### St. Helena College and Career Academy (7-12)

- White button-down shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy blue pants
  - Note: No shorts, Capri, or skirts, or skorts.
  - All pants must be worn at the waist. No sagging or over-sized pants will be allowed.
- Black or navy blue belt
- All black shoes or all black tennis
- All black or white socks

### Outerwear for Both Schools

- Navy blue vest
- Black button-down cardigan
- All black or navy blue jacket/coat

### WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED

- Denim or denim-like fabrics
- Brand name logos on clothing or outerwear
- Multi-colored socks or belts
- Colorful undergarments under school shirt
